
Y4 - Maths - Multiplication - Lesson 2 - ANSWERS



5x7=35 ice-creams



Plastic cups are sold in packs of 8

Amir needs 27 cups.





8×4=32

How many packs must he buy?

There are 30 paper plates in a pack. Amir buys 2 packs.

How many plates are left?

This is a two step word problem

First, we need to do 30x2 (which is like 3x2 but 10 times bigger). I know 3x2=6 so 30x2=60.

Amir must buy 4 packs.

He uses 37 of the 60 plates and we need to find how many he has left. This is a subtraction.

60-37= 23

He has 23 plates left.

Ken buys 3 large boxes and 2 small boxes of chocolates.

Each large box has 48 chocolates. Each small box has 24 chocolates.



Small 24 chocolates This is another two step problem.

First I need to find how many chocolates are in three

48x3.

Then I need to find how many are in two small boxes.

We then need to add the two products together to find how many chocolates Ken bought altogether.

How many chocolates did Ken buy altogether?
