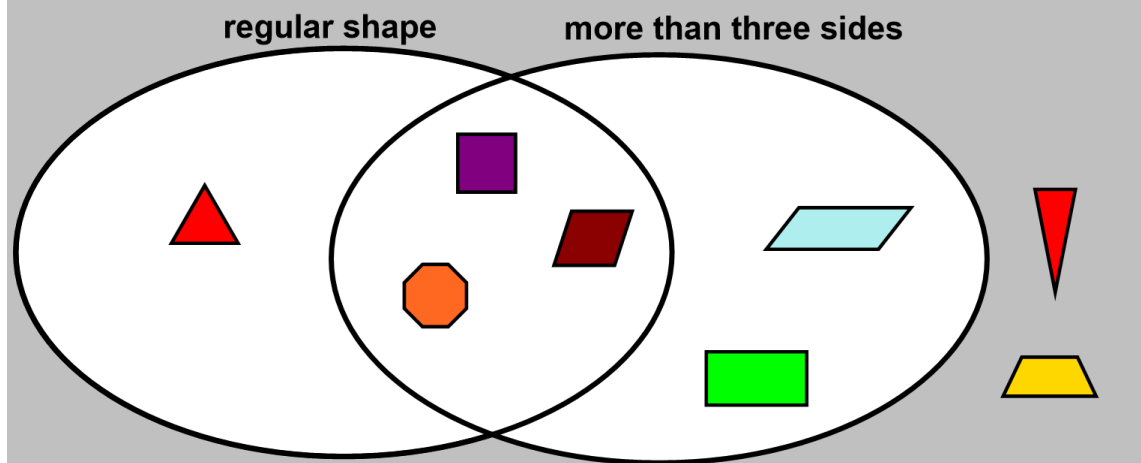
Identify and explain the two mistakes in the Venn diagram.
