### LO: to interpret pictograms

Favourite Colour

Colour	Number of Children
Red	8
Blue	6
Green	4
Yellow	10
Pink	6

Answer the following questions.

1. What is the least favourite colour? green
2. How many children chose yellow as their favourite colour? 9
3. How many fewer children chose green than blue as their favourite colour? 2
4. How many children chose pink and red as their favourite colour? 14

Write your own questions for a friend.

Year 3 children at Pear Tree School voted for their favourite pie fillings.

They drew a pictogram to show the information.

Filling	Number of Children
Apple	12
Cherry	24
Blueberry	40
Rhubarb	16

- 24 children chose cherry. What is the scale of the pictogram?  
 = 8 children
- How many fewer children chose blueberry than all the children who chose cherry or apple put together?  

24	+	20	=	44
44	-	36	=	8

8 children
- If 4 more children voted for cherry, what would the most popular filling be? blueberry
- How could you improve this pictogram?  
Various answers as long as there's a good explanation.
- Write 2 of your own questions that could be answered using this pictogram.
